## Why study CFAB by Distance Learning?

## How do I register with ICAEW?

You must register as a CFAB student with the ICAEW. We recommend you register online at [www.icaew.com](http://www.icaew.com) and send all the information required to the ICAEW as soon as you decide to study this qualification, it can take four weeks for the registration to be completed.

The six modules are examined via six computer-based e-learning assessments. You will have one and a half hours to complete each exam and a maximum four attempts at each module.
